**Jewish Main Beliefs**

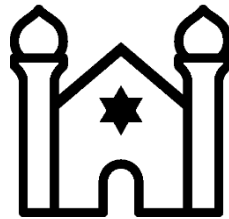

Abraham is the father of the Jewish people.



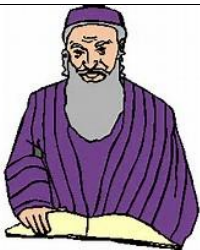
The Jewish sacred text is called the Torah. It is the laws of God given to the Jews by Moses.
