### Turtle

Year 6, have worked hard to finish their Winter work this week. It has now been combined to create a wonderful display in the corridor. On top of this, they have been sitting 'mock sats' which they have tried their best on and never gave up! In maths, we have continued to work with fractions and multiplying them with whole numbers.

### Angelfish

It's beginning to look a lot like Christmas... We have been busy using pastels, wax crayon, paint and glitter to create some wonderful pieces of art work for our Winter Display. The children have also written some lovely poems based around Winter and Jack Frost. In maths, we have been learning about sharing and grouping in multiplication and division. We have lots more children moving up the reading chart this half term- keep it up as there will be a prize for every child who reaches the top! Thank you for your support this half term.

### Parrot Fish

This week Parrot Fish have been multiplying and dividing numbers by 10, 100 and 1000. In talk for writing we have been writing captivating stories about space. We have also been making and decorating lanterns, with an Aladdin theme, for the Christmas tree at the church. In science we have been investigating the effect of magnets to see which materials are magnetic.

### Stingray

This week we have adventured into the world of 3D shape. I've been so impressed at how quickly the children have learnt the names and features that we've moved on to hexagonal and octagonal prisms! In writing our focus has been to create a descriptive piece of writing around a setting. We chose the beach -great for our current weather! During the afternoon we have moved on to looking at seasonal changes and the children have been demonstrating their knowledge through different medias.

### Lobster

Lobster Class have had an amazing week at school! We moved onto learning about multiplying and dividing by 10 and 100. Children found this difficult at first but then found short cuts to make it easier. They could solve reasoning and problem solving calculations well. We have been sketching the Black Dog from our winter story. Children have done their own amazing interpretations of the Black Dog.

### Seahorse

This week, the children have been investigating the life cycle of a dinosaur. We have talked about dinosaur eggs, hatchlings and adult dinosaurs. We even watched some dinosaur eggs hatch! We now have a class Stegosaurus and a class Spinosaurus. Some caring Seahorses worked together and made a nest for them out of different materials. Next week, we will transform into Palaeontologists and dig for fossils.
