Africa—has the most amount of countries in it.


Antarctica - has the least amount of people living in it.

North and South America—have massive mountain ranges running through them.



Job: Explorer


Born: England

Wanted to be the first person to reach the South Pole.

Expedition 1: 1901-1904

Failed to reach the pole.

Expedition 2: In 1910 Scott set off again. He reached the pole in January 1912 two years later. Unfortunately another team had got there before him.



Name: Ernest Shackleton

Job: Explorer

Born: England

Wanted to be the first person to reach the South Pole.

Expedition 1: Part of Scott's team in 1901.

Expedition 2: In 1907 Shackleton return to the South Pole but had to turn back 111miles from the pole.
